- (a) India is the second largest country in the world after China in terms of number of mobile telephone connections and it continues to expand as per following details:

- (b) In the third quarter of 2015, India registered an addition of 13.95 million mobile telephone connections i.e. 1.75 connection per second. As per the estimates based on International Telecomm Union (ITU) data for 2015, China saw an increase of 1.47 million mobile telephone connections during the same period.
