- (a) whether the Government has made a study on the impact of demonetization on real estate sector and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether experts have expressed that market value of residential property is expected to be wiped off in about 42 cities across the country; and
- (c) if so, the response of the Government thereto and the details of efforts proposed to be made to boost the real estate sector market?

- (a): No Madam, this Ministry has not carried out any study on impact of demonetization on real estate sector.

(c): Demonetization coupled with the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act, 2016, the Goods and Service Tax Law and the *Benami* Transactions (Prohibition) (Amendment) Act, 2016 is expected to increase transparency in the sector and attract higher volume of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) at competitive rates.
