- (b) The recommendations of 7th Central Pay Commission with regard to pay and pension were approved by the Government for implementation during 2016-17 and accordingly, the operating ratio of Railways in Revised Estimates 2016-17 was estimated at 94.9%.
- Madam. Railways (c) & (d) Yes, had, through number of correspondences/submissions at various levels, sought assistance from the Ministry of Finance in some way or the other to meet the additional liability arising out of implementation of 7th Central Pay Commission. The Ministry of Finance, however, advised Railways to explore raising own resources for implementation of the recommendations of 7th Central Pay Commission stating that the liability of General Revenues towards implementation of the recommendations of 7th Central Pay Commission is much larger in comparison to liability of Ministry of Railways.
