- (c) whether the Government has issued guidelines prohibiting the use of arable land and land on which local people have their houses in for establishment of new industries/factories and for using waste land for the said purpose and if so, the details thereof?

It is the prerogative of the states to adopt the instrumentalities of National Manufacturing Policy.
