## 686. SHRI C.R. PATIL:

SHRIMATI DARSHANA VIKRAM JARDOSH:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether proposals have been received by the Government from various States including Gujarat under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme for development of International Buddhist Circuit covering the various places in those States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the present status of the proposals;
- (c) whether any such project is being considered as a special project under Swadesh Darshan Scheme and that its planning and implementation is being supplemented by accessing funds from various international Multilateral Agencies; and
- (d) whether the Government has identified an international funding agency for financing the project and if so, the details of those agencies?

(a) to (d): Buddhist Circuit has been identified as one of the thirteen thematic circuits for development under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme.
