LIBRARY POLICY

690. SHRI PR. SUNDARAM:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note that library support staff have not been provided as prescribed in the New Library Policy and Procedural Manual approved by KVS and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor:
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to improve the facilities for temporary teachers and non teaching staff like librarians in Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) etc.;
- (c) whether the Librarians and other non teaching staff are given extra works/duties like taking primary classes, making lab/class room arrangements in the Kendriya Vidyalaya Schools; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the vacancy position in KVs in the country in Teaching and Non-Teaching staffs as well as Librarians, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT
(SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)**

- (a) The Guidelines for School Library and Procedure Manual developed by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) provides for one Librarian and one Sub Staff for the Library of the school. The Principals of the Vidyalayas have been authorized by KVS to detail one of the sub staff members available in the school to assist the librarian.
- (b) Librarians are regular staff and are entitled to all the benefits at par with regular Trained Graduate Teachers (TGT) of all other subjects.
- (c) No extra unprofessional work/duties are given to librarians. However, the arrangement periods (substitution work) may be given sometimes as per exigency of service in the interest of the organization.
- (d) The State/UT-wise details of vacant posts in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country of teaching & non-teaching staff as well as Librarians as on 1.11.2016 are annexed.
