(a) to (c) The estimated project cost for improvement of connectivity to Chardham through old National Highways no. 58, 94, 108 & 109 from Rishikesh to Kedarnath, Badrinath, Gangotri, Yamunotri and Tanakpur-Pithoragarh section of NH 125 is about Rs. 11700 Crore including the cost of land acquisition and pre-construction activities. The project is scheduled for completion by 2020. The fund allocated for this project during current Financial Year is Rs 2070 Crore.
