800. SHRIMATI RANJEET RANJAN:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the reasons for the severe shortfall in the wheat procurement by various Government agencies despite increased wheat production in 2016-17 in comparison to 2015-16;
- (b) whether the Government has taken measures to address the shortfall in wheat procurement and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the total requirement of wheat stock for domestic consumption and the total quantum of wheat consumed in the country during 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively;
- (d) the total wheat stock available (including imported wheat that was already contracted to arrive) in the country and the reasons for scrapping wheat import duty on December 8, 2016;
- (e) the total quantum of wheat imported by the country in 2016 during the period of March-August, September-November and December respectively along with the month-wise data on the percentage of duty applied on the export of wheat from the country in 2016-17 and 2015-16 respectively; and
- (f) the month-wise data on quantum of wheat exported from India in 2016 during the period of March-August, September- November and December?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI C. R. CHAUDHARY)

(a): The procurement of wheat in Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2016-17 was 229.61 Lakh Metric Ton (LMT) against procurement of 280.88 LMT in RMS 2015-16.

The foremost reason for shortfall in wheat procurement by various Government agencies despite increased wheat production in 2016-17 in comparison to 2015-16 is proactive buying of wheat by private players in the state of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan.

(b): Procurement in RMS 2016-17 was lower as compared to previous two years but the stock position of wheat was more than the buffer and strategic norms as given in the table below:-

(d): The total wheat stock available in Central Pool is 137.47 LMT as on 01.01.2017 against stocking norms of 128.00 LMT. No wheat has been imported since 2008-09 on Government account. However, the quantum of wheat imported in 2016 is at Annexure.

The procurement of wheat in RMS 2016-17 was 229.61 LMT against procurement of 280.88 LMT in RMS 2015-16 & 280.23 LMT in RMS 2014-15. To make more wheat available in the Open Market in the country through import to contain the domestic price of wheat, GOI reduced the import duty from 25% to 10% vide notification dated 23.09.2016 and then further from 10% to 0% vide notification dated 08.12.2016.

(e) & (f): The total quantum of wheat imported and exported by the country in 2015 and 2016 month-wise is at Annexure.
