- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of such cases reported along with the number of smugglers arrested during the last one year and the current year;
- (c) whether the role of Indian security personnel deployed on Indo-Bangladesh border has been investigated in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken against the personnel involved in the said smugglings?
