- (a) the instances of infiltration reported, number of security personnel and civilians killed and injured along with the number of infiltrators arrested and killed during each of the last three years and the current year, border-wise and State-wise;
- (b) the total length of international borders which India shares with China, Myanmar, Bangladesh and Bhutan in North East Region;
- (c) whether the terrorists have damaged the fencing at borders to infiltrate;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the corrective measures taken thereon;
- (e) whether the Government has set up a committee to formulate the strategy regarding anti-infiltration and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the measures taken to check infiltration along the borders including erecting concrete walls to check infiltration?
