(b) & (c): 'Police' being State subject, the State Governments have to implement various police reforms and welfare measures, including housing facilities for women police personnel.

Further, police reform measures are also supported through the grants-inaid released to the State Governments under the Scheme for Modernisation of State Police Force (MPF) by the Ministry of Home Affairs. The Scheme, as originally approved, covers major items of Police infrastructure including construction of residential buildings for subordinate police.
