Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:
(a) whether the Government proposes to establish mobile towers powered by Solar and other renewable source of energy in remote village areas especially to improve communications in Naxal-hit areas;
(b) if so, the details thereof; and
(c) the details of mobile towers set up which run on green energy, State and operatorwise?

## ANSWER <br> THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS \& MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS <br> (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (c) 1836 new mobile towers based on solar energy are being setup in ten left wing extremist affected States. The work is being executed by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL). As on 31.01.2017, 1831 new mobile towers out of 1836 have been made functional. Further, BSNL has set up 119 mobile towers powered by Solar energy at different locations in the country under other scheme such as Jawahar Lal Nehru Solar Mission etc. State-wise break-up is at Annexure.
