ESTABLISHMENT OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTES

†927. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is making any efforts to establish small Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and promote technical education in various parts of the country particularly in Scheduled Tribes dominated areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/Union Territory-wise including Chhattisgarh;
- (c) the details of the ITIs established in the country as on date State/Union Territory-wise along with the amount of expenditure incurred on establishment of these ITIs during the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) the details of the funds provided/utilized under various heads for ITIs in the country during the said period, State/Union Territory-wise including Chhattisgarh?

(a) & (b) Directorate General of Training, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, is implementing two schemes titled "Skill Development in 47 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism and "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" to establish 22 ITIs in 8 Northeastern States and 47 ITIs in 47 districts of 10 Left Wing Extremism affected States respectively. These two schemes are being implemented mostly in Scheduled Tribe dominated areas. The details of locations of new ITIs showing percentage of ST population including Chhattisgarh are at **Annexure-I**.

Apart from the above, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship had published an advertisement in the month of January 2016 for National Campaign for Skilling regarding establishment of 7000 new ITIs. Status of increase in ITIs and upgradation of seats in existing ITIs may be seen at **Annexure-II**.

(c) & (d) Vocational Training is a concurrent subject under the Constitution (entry 23). The Central Government is entrusted with responsibility of formulation of policy, laying down training standards, norms, conduct of examinations & certification and affiliation/ de-affiliation of ITIs etc., whereas setting up of ITIs (by own funds) and day to day administration including admissions in ITIs is under the domain of respective State/UTs.

As per information captured on NCVTMIS portal as on date, a total of 13350 ITIs are admitting trainees, affiliated to the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) as per the details state-wise list at **Annexure - III**.

The State wise details of the funds provided/utilized during the last three years and current year under the two schemes "Skill Development in 34 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism" and "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" including Chhattisgarh are at **Annexure-IV**.
