(a) to (c): Yes Madam. The Ministry of Urban Development, through Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) provides funds for strengthening basic urban infrastructure in Mission cities. A total of 31 cities of Gujarat have been selected under it. The Ministry has approved all the three State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) of Gujarat under the Mission. The details of the Plans and allocation for water supply sector as well as sewerage and septage management are given as below:-
