- (a) the details of the works started to provide amenities to tourists visiting temples and monuments during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and State/UT-wise:
- (b) the details of the expenditure incurred on these works during the said period, year-wise and State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide adequate security at these temples and monuments; and
- (d) if so, the State/UT-wise details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.120 FOR 24.7.2017

- (a)&(b)Providing basic facilities/amenities (e.g. drinking water, toilet blocks, facilities for physically challenged, pathways, cultural notice boards/signage, vehicle parking, cloak rooms, etc.) to tourists visiting centrally protected temples and monuments and sites are the regular activities which the Archaeological Survey of India undertakes. Improvement and upgradation of these public facilities/amenities is a continuous process. Basic public facilities are available at all World Heritage Sites and ASI's ticketed monuments, as also at majority of those protected monuments that are visited by a large numbers of tourists. Further, Archaeological Survey of India has identified 100 monuments "Adarsh Smarak" as for upgradation facilities/amenities like Wi-Fi, cafeteria, interpretation centre, brail signage, modern toilets etc. on the basis of actual requirement and feasibility on case to case basis. In the case of fund allocation, no specific fund is allotted for the purpose and the expenditure is incurred from regular budget (for conservation and maintenance) of Archaeological Survey of India. The expenditure incurred on conservation & maintenance of centrally protected monuments including providing tourist amenities during the last three years and current year (State/UT-wise) is at Annexure-I.
- (c)&(d) Archaeological Survey of India has deployed regular watch & ward staff (Monument Attendants) at centrally protected monuments/sites. Further, private security guards, Armed Guards and CISF personnel have also been engaged at select monuments for safety and protection. The State/UT-wise details of deployment of security personnel at centrally protected monuments/sites are at Annexure-II.
