Haj Pilgrimage

*148. SHRIMATI KOTHAPALLI GEETHA:

Will the Minister of **MINORITY AFFAIRS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals/ applications for Haj Pilgrimage during the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of proposals/ applications received / admitted/ rejected and the present status thereof, State/ UT-wise particularly from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana; and
- (c) the financial assistance presently being provided to the Haj pilgrim?

ANSWER

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.148 FOR 26.07.2017 RAISED BY SHRIMATI KOTHAPALLI GEETHA REGARDING HAJ PILGRIMAGE

(a) to (c) Haj Committee of India, a statutory organization under the Ministry of Minority Affairs invited applications from intending Haj pilgrims from 02.01.2017 to 06.02.2017. The total number of Haj applications received in the Haj Committee of India was 4,48,266, out of which 1,23,700 pilgrims have been selected for Haj 2017. The State/Union Territory-wise applications received and number of pilgrims selected including for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is given in Annexure.

The expenditure towards Haj is borne by the pilgrims themselves. No financial assistance is given directly to the Haj pilgrims. However for air travel of pilgrims, the Ministry of Civil Aviation makes air chartering arrangements through a bidding process among the Indian and Saudi airlines. The airfare for each embarkation points is arrived at through the bidding process. In order to mitigate air travel costs for Haj pilgrims, Ministry of Civil Aviation provides subsidy (popularly known as Haj subsidy) which is the difference between actual airfare discovered through bidding process and the fixed uniform amount charged by Haj Committee of India towards airfare. This subsidy is paid directly to the airlines and per unit subsidy differs from embarkation point to embarkation point.

The Supreme Court, while dealing with the Special Leave Petition (Civil) No.28609 of 2011 vide its judgment dated 08.05.2012, inter alia observed that the Haj subsidy is something that is best done away with and directed the central Government to progressively reduce the amount of subsidy so as to completely eliminate it. Accordingly, Haj subsidy has been gradually reduced from Rs.836.56 in the year 2012 to Rs. 405 crore in the year 2016.
