The erstwhile AI had placed an order of 68 Boeing Aircraft in December, 2005 and the erstwhile IA had placed an order for 43 Airbus Aircraft in February, 2006.
- (c) & (d): FIR has already been registered by CBI regarding the alleged irregularities in procurement/purchase of aircraft.
