(a): At present 14 scheduled domestic airlines are operating in the country.

(b) to (d): As per the details provided by airlines to DGCA for year 2016-17, Air India, Air India Express, Go Air, Indigo, Jet Airways, JetLite, Spicejet and Blue Dart have made operating profit, whereas 5 domestic airlines have incurred loses during this period. Since Zoom Air has started its operation in February, 2017, no such financial results are available. Further, each airline prepares its business plan on the basis of their own market assessment and therefore the reasons for incurring losses differs from airline to airline, for which no centralized data is maintained by Government.
