STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARRED QUSTION NO. 243 BY SHRI RAM CHARITRA NISHAD TO BE ANSWERED ON 02.08.2017 REGARDING RAIL ENGINEERS

- (a): Yes, Madam. A Memorandum of Co-operation (MoC) has been signed between Government of India and Government of Japan on 12.12.2015 to implement the Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Project with technical and financial assistance of Japan which also envisages training of 4000 officials of Indian Railways.
- (b): Yes, Madam. "Training Programme for Young Officers of the Ministry of Railways (MoR)" has commenced and 137 officers have so far been trained in the Programme.
- (c)&(d): Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) project has been sanctioned for implementation with technical and financial assistance of Government of Japan. Procurement of High Speed rolling stock is an integral part of the project that envisages promoting Make in India of high speed rolling stock in a phased manner.
