**GRADUATED DRIVERS LICENSING SYSTEM**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to adopt the Graduated Drivers Licensing System followed by many countries around the world;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of a recent study indicating that 6 out of 10 driving licenses in India are awarded without a proper test for the purpose and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) No, Madam. However, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways do undertake studies on best practices globally. Similarly, we shall also look at these systems.

(c) The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways does not maintain centralised data about testing of drivers for issue of licence. Implementation of related provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (MV Act) and the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (CMVRs) come under the purview of State Transport Departments. Section 19(1)(e) of MV Act provides for disqualifying a person for a specified period for holding or obtaining any driving licence if a Licensing Authority is satisfied that he has obtained driving licence by fraud or misrepresentation.

(d) The Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Bill, 2017, passed by Lok Sabha and presently pending in Rajya Sabha, provides for centralised register of driving licences. This will further help to carry reforms in the driving licence testing process and eliminating the duplicate licences.
