MATERNITY BENEFIT PROGRAMME

*297. SHRI MD. BADARUDDOZA KHAN: SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of child births and the number of children died during delivery during the last three years, State/UT and gender-wise;
- (b) whether Government has implemented any Maternity Benefit Programme for providing payment of ₹ 6000 to Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers, if so, the salient features thereof including cost sharing pattern of the programme and funds required for the purpose;
- (c) the funds allocated/released and utilised during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (d) the number of beneficiaries under the programme since its inception, State/UT and year-wise; and
- (e) the monitoring mechanism put in place by the Government to ensure that the benefits of the programme reach the beneficiaries in a timely manner?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI)

(a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

<u>Statement referred to in reply to part (a) to (e) of the Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 297 for answer on 04.08.2017 raised by Shri Md. Badaruddoza Khan and Shri Vishnu Dayal Ram regarding Maternity Benefit Programme</u>

- (a): As per the National Health Management System (HMIS), the number of live births and number of still births during the last three years are at **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively. Gender-wise disaggregated data is not collected at national level.
- (b): The Government of India has approved Pan-India implementation of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) with effect from 01.01.2017. PMMVY envisages payment of maternity benefits of ₹ 5,000/- in beneficiary's bank/post office account in three instalments at the stage of early registration of pregnancy, after six months of pregnancy with at least one antenatal check-up and registration of child birth & completion of first cycle of immunisation of the child. The eligible beneficiary is to receive the remaining cash incentive as per approved norms towards Maternity Benefit under Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) after institutional delivery so that on an average, a woman gets ₹ 6000/-. The salient features of the PMMVY is at Annexure-III.

The PMMVY is Centrally Sponsored Scheme under which the cost sharing ratio between the Centre and the States & UTs with Legislature is 60:40, for eight North-Eastern States & three Himalayan States, it is 90:10 and 100% Central assistance for Union Territories without Legislature.

- (c): Prior to introduction of PMMVY, the Ministry of Women and Child Development was implementing a Maternity Benefit Programme (erstwhile Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana) for pregnant women and lactating mothers on pilot basis in 53 selected districts across the country. The State/UT-wise and year-wise details of funds released and utilisation reported under the programme during the last three years is at **Annexure-IV**. So far, no fund has been released under the PMMVY during the current financial year of 2017-18.
- (d): The number of beneficiaries covered under the programme since its inception during the year 2010-11 is at **Annexure-V**.
- (e): Under PMMVY all the payments to beneficiaries are to be made to the Bank/Post Office account of the beneficiary in the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode which will be recorded on Central Management Information System (MIS) and monitored at various levels. Beside this the Committees at Village, Block, District, State/UT and National level will regularly monitor the scene.

Salient features of the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)

- (i) The maternity benefit, are available to a woman for the first living child of family subject to fulfilment of conditionalities. All the pregnant women and lactating mothers in regular employment with Central Government or State Governments or Public Sector Undertakings or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force, are excluded.
- (ii) The conditionalities and number of instalments under PMMVY are as under:

- (iii) Mother and Child Protection Card (MCP) Card is the verification tool for verification of fulfillment of conditionalities.
- (iv) Early registration of pregnancy has been considered as registration of pregnancy within 150 days from the date of her Last Menstrual Period (LMP) and duly recorded on MCP Card.
- (v) All Pregnant Women who have registered their pregnancy for the first child in family on or after 01.01.2017 are eligible for getting benefit under the programme. For this purpose, LMP for the women should be on or after 01.04.2016 and date of birth of the child should be on or after 01.01.2017. However, such beneficiaries will get maternity benefits in respect of the condition(s) which have been fulfilled on or after 01.01.2017.
- (vi) The funds to the beneficiaries under PMMVY will be transferred directly to their Bank/Post Office account in Direct Benefit Transfer Mode.
- (vii) If a beneficiary delivers twins/triplet/quadruplet, it will be counted as first live child in the family.
- (viii) A beneficiary can apply, at any point of time but not later than two years of pregnancy.
- (ix) The Aadhaar Card of beneficiary and her husband shall be captured. The beneficiaries have to submit identification details as per Section 7 of Aadhaar Act 2016. The States of Assam, Meghalaya and Jammu & Kashmir are exempted from this.
- (x) The grants-in-aid will be transferred in ESCROW Account as well as State/UT treasury for different components of the scheme. For the maternity benefit component (Conditional Cash Transfer of ₹ 5,000/-) under PMMVY is to be transferred to the Escrow Account of the States/UTs to be maintained at State/UT level. For the remaining components such as setting up of State and District PMMVY Cells, Training & Capacity Building of stake holders, Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Material, Flexi Fund etc. is to be routed through State/UT's Treasury Account. This has been done to maintain transparency in accounts and proper monitoring of implementation of the programme.
- (xi) The beneficiaries of erstwhile Maternity Benefit Programme can also avail maternity benefits for remaining amount on fulfilment of eligibility and conditionalities under PMMVY.
- (xii) At the Centre, the scheme is being implemented by Ministry of Women and Child Development. The States/UTs have option to implement the scheme either through Women & Child Development Department/Social Welfare Department or through Health & Family Welfare Department.
