(a) the details of the actual demand, production and supply of milk in the country, State-wise;

(b) the steps taken by the Government to promote dairy farming in the country along with the incentives provided by the Government in this regard; and

(c) the details of the proposals/projects/ schemes implemented by the Government to strengthen the milk cooperatives in the country?

ANSWER THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI RADHA MOHAN SINGH)

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.316 PUT IN BY SHRI J.C. DIVAKAR REDDY REGARDING "DEMAND, PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY OF MILK" DUE FOR ANSWER ON 8THAUGUST, 2017.

(a) As per Economic Survey 2010-11, the production of milk in the country is required to increase to 180 million tonnes by 2021-22 to meet the demand. The milk production during 2016-17 is estimated to be 163.56 million tonnes. Accordingly, the milk production at national level is by and large sufficient to meet the domestic demand of milk and milk products. The State-wise estimated milk production during 2016-17 is **annexed**.

(b) & (c)The Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries is implementing following schemes for strengthening milk cooperatives in various States of the country:-

i. Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (DEDS)

Under DEDS, 2,74,396 projects for setting up of dairy units and other related units by entrepreneurs/farmers/milk producing farmer groups have been approved in 29 States and 1 UT with total subsidy assistance of Rs. 1085.24 crore disbursed by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) upto 30.06.2017.

ii. National Dairy Plan (Phase I) (NDP-I)

Under NDP-I, 390 sub projects from Cooperative Societies/Federations/Milk Unions in 18 major milk producing States have been approved with total approved outlay of Rs.1993.20 crore upto 30.06.2017.

iii. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)

Under NPDD, 53 projects in 23 States and 1 UT have been approved with the total outlay of Rs.516.47 crore upto 30.06.2017 for Cooperative Societies/Milk Unions/Federations/Milk producing Farmer groups.
