- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has received any recommendation from the authorities concerned for filling up these vacant posts;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) the details of such appointments made during the last three years?

(a) to (e): Tribunals/Commissions etc., functioning under the Government of India are administered by the various Ministries/Departments as per the subject allocated to them under the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961. At present, the Department of Legal Affairs is administering the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal (ITAT). The information pertaining to ITAT in respect of parts (a) to (e) of the question is as follows:
