- (c) whether any scheme has been formulated to set up new textile mills in the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of operational and nonoperational textile mills in Karnataka?

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *341 TO BE ANSWERED ON 10.08.2017.

- (a): There are 1399 Textile Mills (Non-Small Scale Industry) in operation in the country as on 30.06.2017. State-wise details of Mills in operation are at Annexure-I.
- **(b):** As on 30.06.2017, there are 682 closed Textile Mills (Non-Small Scale Industry) in the country. State-wise details of closed mills are at Annexure-II.
- Yes, Madam. The Government launched the Amended Technology (c): Upgradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) on 13.01.2016 under which benefits in terms of one time capital subsidy i.e. @ 15% for the garmenting and technical textiles segments with a cap of Rs.30 crores and @ 10% for segments like weaving, processing, jute, silk and handloom with a subsidy cap of Rs.20 crores are available for setting up of new textiles units or expansion of existing units with bench marked technology. Government has also launched Scheme for Production and Employment Linked Support for Garmenting Units (SPELSGU) in July, 2016 under which an additional subsidy of 10% is available to new textile units or expansion of existing units on their achieving the projected target of production and employment generation, as stated by the units in the Detailed Project Report (DPR). Similar benefit has also been extended for the made-ups segment. The cap on capital investment subsidy for eligible machines in each garmenting and made-ups unit has accordingly been enhanced from Rs.30 crores to Rs. 50 crores under ATUFS.
- (d): As on 30.06.2017, there were 18 operational and 27 closed Textile Mills (Non-Small Scale Industry) in Karnataka.
