STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 51 BY SHRI RAJAN VICHARE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 19.07.2017 REGARDING NEW ELEVATED CORRIDOR

(a) and (b): The work for new elevated rail corridor between Airoli and Kalwa under MUTP-III has been taken up and there is no delay. The preliminary Engineering works involving final location survey, submission of land acquisition proposals to Collector and Geo Technical Investigations have been completed. Baseline Socio Economic Survey for Project Affected Persons (PAP) has been taken up. Tender for construction of Dighe station, subway and bridges at an approximate cost of ₹ 107.20 crore has been invited. The estimated completion cost of project is ₹ 476 crore.
