- (a) whether the pilot project of the Nai Manzil scheme which seeks to skill and educate minority youths who are school dropouts or educated in community institutions such as Madarsas has been implemented in a smooth manner and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the pilot project has been successful in achieving its objective of reaching out to 1200 minority youths in eight States namely, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Meghalaya, Haryana, Telangana, Karnataka, Rajasthan and West Bengal, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Ministry plans to implement the scheme in other States including Kerala; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

SHASHI THAROOR REGARDING “NAI MANZIL SCHEME”**

(a) The Pilot Project on Nai Manzil was launched on 8.8.2015 at Bihar by Maulana Azad Education Foundation, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Minority Affairs. The pilot project is implemented in 8 states given as under:

1.	Bihar	-	Patna, Muzzaffarpur
2.	Meghalaya	-	Nongstoin
3.	Uttar Pradesh	-	Lucknow
4.	Haryana	-	Mewat
5.	Telangana	-	Tandur
6.	Karnataka	-	Belgaum
7.	Rajasthan	-	Bilwara, Alwar
8.	West Bengal	-	Siliguri, Kalingpong.

The 1st phase has been completed under which training of 1274 trainees has been completed.

In addition, 741 students were enrolled for the phase II in the following 5 states:-

1.	Bihar	-	Chappra, Kanti
2.	Uttar Pradesh	-	Kanpur, Lucknow
3.	Haryana	-	Mewat
4.	Rajasthan	-	Jaipur, Alwar
5.	Gujarat	-	Mehsana.

(b) The project is ongoing.

(c) & (d) Yes, while there is no state-wise allocation of projects, the scheme is being implemented in 23 states. The state-wise details are annexed.
