***63. PROF. RICHARD HAY:**

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and the percentage of households without toilet facility at present across the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilised for construction of toilets during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of public toilets constructed during the said period, State/ UT-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has faced any problem while constructing these toilets in some of the States and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard, State/UT-wise?

Statement referred to in reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No. *63 for 20.07.2017

- (a) State/UT-wise, number and the percentage of households without toilet facility in rural areas as on 17.7.2017 is at Annexure-1.
- (b) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is a demand driven scheme. States make demand for funds through their Annual Implementation Plans (AIP), and the central funds are allocated among States subject to availability based on the AIP demands and the State's performance on Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin). State/UT-wise, central share released and utilised during last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-2.
- (c) State/ UT-wise, number of Community Sanitary Complexes constructed during last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-3.
- (d) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is a behaviour change program, and States are encouraged to motivate the beneficiaries to construct their own toilets and use them. Some States have different terrain conditions, and States are adapting the toilet technology to suit their requirements appropriately.
