(c) whether the Government has notified the final beneficiaries under Antara Programme which was scheduled to commence from 1st April, 2017; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & b): An incentive scheme for ASHA is available only for the identified 146 districts under Mission Parivar Vikas where ASHA is paid an amount of Rs.100 for escorting a client to the health facility for administering a dose of Injectable Contraceptive.

(c) : The Government does not notify the beneficiaries for any contraceptive choice because Family Planning program is target free which promotes voluntary adoption of Family Planning choices by the couples as per their reproductive rights.
