DEVELOPMENT FINANCE BODY FOR WOMEN SELF HELP GROUPS

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up a Development Finance Body for the benefit of women self-help groups;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Ministry of Finance has agreed on the proposal and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): No Madam. There is no such proposal by the Government to set up a Development Finance Body for the benefit of women self-help groups.

However, Rashtriya Mahila Kosh (RMK) is an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Women & Child Development (MWCD) set up during 1993 as a society registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 and an apex micro-finance organization to provide micro-credit at concessional rate of interest to women Self Help Groups or individual women (the ultimate beneficiaries) through Intermediary Micro-financing Organizations (IMOs) /Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs)/ Voluntary Organisations (VOs) for various livelihood support and income generating activities.
