Identification of Degree Certificates

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the University Grants Commission has directed all universities and educational institutes to introduce identification mechanisms in degrees and certificates awarded by them;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the universities and educational institutions have also been asked to inscribe the name of the institution in which a student is enrolled as well as the mode of delivery; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. The University Grants Commission (UGC) vide its letter dated 21st March, 2017 had requested all the Universities to introduce identification mechanisms like photograph and Unique ID/Aadhaar number in students' certificates. UGC also requested all the Universities to inscribe the name of institution in which a student is enrolled for a program of study as well as the mode of delivery (regular, part-time or distance).
