- (c) whether the Government has announced a Startup exchange programme amongst the SAARC Nations recently; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b):** Yes Madam, Startup India Virtual Hub was launched on 19th June, 2017. It is an online platform for all stakeholders of the entrepreneurial ecosystem in India to discover, connect and engage with each other. The portal hosts startups, investors, funds, mentors, academia, incubators, accelerators, corporates and Government bodies. The Hub attempts to solve the problem of information asymmetry and lack of access to knowledge, tools and experts, especially in the nascent ecosystems across Tier II and III cities.
- (c) & (d):** There has been no such formal announcement for a Startup exchange program amongst the SAARC nations. However, the government is considering an event for startups from SAARC nations.
