Development of Ayad River

1386. SHRI ARJUN LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to release Rs. 87.49 crores for the development of Ayad river, a tributary of the Berach river under the National River Conservation Plan;
- (b) if so, the time by which the funds are likely to be released; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. HARSH VARDHAN)

(a) to (c) A project proposal for 'Abatement of pollution, river flow channelization and river front beautification of Berech (Ayad) river in Udaipur' was received from Rajasthan Urban Infrastructure Finance Development Corporation Limited (RUIFDCO), Jaipur for consideration under National River Conservation Plan (NRCP) in May 2015. However, the proposal was returned back to RUIFDCO as river Ayad is a part of Ganga River Basin and does not come under the purview of NRCP. Therefore, there is no proposal to release Rs. 87.49 crore for the project under NRCP.
