CYCLONE SHELTERS

1407. SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of cyclone shelters presently functional in the country, Statewise;
- (b) the amount extended by the Government to each of these cyclone shelters;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up more cyclone shelters; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (d): The details of cyclone shelters, built by the State Governments, are not centrally maintained by this Ministry. However, the Government of India has approved the National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) in eight (08) Coastal States in two phases to address the vulnerability of coastal community to cyclone. NCRMP Phase-I approved in January, 2011 covers the States of Andhra Pradesh & Odisha with project period of 2011-2018, while NCRMP Phase-II covers the States of Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra and West Bengal with project period of 2015-2020.
