**(a) whether the Government has detected any anti-national activities along kutch border with Pakistan;**

**(b) if so, the details thereof;**

**(c) whether the Government has commissioned satellite monitored laser walls along the fencing of Indo-Pakistan international border in Punjab;**

**(d) if so, whether the Government is considering to commission similar type of satellite monitored laser walls along the fencing of the Indo-Pakistan international border in Gujarat; and**

**(e) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) & (b): No case of Anti-National activities, that is, smuggling of weapons/contrabands/Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) as well as infiltration have been reported in Border Security Force (BSF) Area of Responsibility (AOR) along Kutch border with Pakistan.**

**(c): No satellite monitored Laser Wall has been commissioned on Indo-Pakistan International Border in Punjab.**

**(d) & (e): At present, no such proposal is under consideration.**
