## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) & (b): No case of Anti-National activities, that is, smuggling of

weapons/contrabands/Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) as well as

infiltration have been reported in Border Security Force (BSF) Area of

Responsibility (AOR) along Kutch border with Pakistan.

(c): No satellite monitored Laser Wall has been commissioned on Indo-

Pakistan International Border in Punjab.

(d) & (e): At present, no such proposal is under consideration.
