- (a): As per the latest employment-unemployment survey conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) during its 68th round (July 2011 June 2012), the unemployment rate in rural India based on usual status (principal and subsidiary) has increased from 1.6 per cent in 2009-10 to 1.7 per cent in 2011-12. The change in unemployment rate in agriculture sector is not separately estimated in the survey.
- (b) & (c): The existing schemes for development of agriculture sector have provisions for supply of seeds, plant protection chemicals, nutrients (secondary, micro and bio-nutrients), agricultural machinery and equipments, credit, etc., at subsidized rates to the farmers in the country, including small and medium farmers.
