Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the schemes being formulated by the Government for naxal affected areas and the schemes on which work is being done along with the time by which it is likely to be completed, State-wise;

(b) the funds allocated for the development of naxal affected States during the last three years and the amount spent out of those funds;

(c) the amount being spent by the Government every year for safety measures and development works in the naxal affected States;

(d) the steps taken to complete development schemes in naxal affected States on time;

(e) whether the Government proposes to provide complete financial assistance to the States for raising special police force; and

(f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): The Government is committed for holistic development of LWE affected areas at par with other parts of the country. Apart from Schemes of the various Union Ministries / Departments, several schemes, Road Requirement Plan-I (RRP-I), Installation of Mobile Towers, Skill Development Scheme, etc. have been launched for development of LWE

affected areas. Details of allocations/releases and expenditure of some of the development schemes and security related schemes are given in Annexure-A.

(d): The Steps taken for speedy completion of schemes are:

- **Deployment of CAPFs,**
- **Special relaxations and dispensations,**
- **Coordination with the Ministries/Departments and States to remove bottlenecks/difficulties,**
- **Regular monitoring of schemes at the level of HM/HS and the Cabinet Secretary, and**
- **Setting up of the Empowered Committee, under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (LWE).**
