CBI INVESTIGATION AGAINST PONZI COMPANIES

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has received complaints against various ponzi companies for fraud and scams;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether CBI has filed charge-sheet against those companies and investigation has been initiated:
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the present status of investigation and action taken against ponzi companies?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): Yes, Madam. CBI has registered and investigated cases against various Ponzi Companies for fraud and scams on the basis of complaints received/directions of the Court.CBI has registered 115 cases against such companies for fraud and scams from 01.01.2014 till 30.06.2017. Further, CBI has filed charge sheets in 56 cases during this period.
