Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed a common mobile application or platform across the country for all Government services such as passports, income tax, health, women safety and scholarships etc.;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and whether the Government has also taken initiatives for the introduction of such common platform with the coordination of State Governments; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government to make it prevalent across the country?

(a) to (c) Yes Madam, Government has initiated UMANG (Unified Mobile App for New age Governance) platform and UMANG mobile App on Android & iOS. UMANG is a common unified platform and mobile App to facilitate single point access for major Central and State Government services like health, agriculture, education etc. through a mobile and is available in multiple languages. Presently, UMANG website (www.umang.gov.in) has been soft launched with beta version for user feedback.

More than 80 services have already been on-boarded on UMANG. These include student related Apps like CBSE, ePathshala of NCERT & All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), farmer's crop Insurance information & Soil Health Card, Apps related to health – Online Registration (ORS) of patient, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY) App and Prime Minister Aawas Yojna (PMAY) App, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, Employee Provident Fund (EPFO), Digisevak, Rapid Assessment System (RAS) for feedback, Vaahan, National Pension Scheme (NPS), e-Migrate, Gas booking.
