CHINESE ADVISORY TO TRAVELLERS

- (a) whether China has issued safety advisory to its citizens travelling to India; and**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?**

(a) & (b) Yes. Government has seen that the Embassy of People's Republic of China in New Delhi on its website has placed a notice in Chinese language on July 7, 2017 valid for one month, advising its nationals inter alia that they should enhance safety precautions, carry personal identification proof, speak and act cautiously, strictly abide by the Indian laws and regulations and cooperate with local law enforcement personnel during inspections. The notice does not provide any details explaining the reasons or circumstances for placing this notice.
