SOUTHERN FREIGHT CORRIDOR

1674. SHRIMATI MEENAKASHI LEKHI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways is in the process of developing a Southern Freight Corridor (SFC) which would be connected to one of the three dedicated freight corridors; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) : No, Madam. Presently, only two Freight Corridors, namely, Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor and Western Dedicated Freight Corridor have been sanctioned. Feasibility studies have been carried out for three Freight Corridors, namely, (i) East-West Corridor (Kolkata-Mumbai); (ii) North-South Corridor (Delhi-Chennai); and (iii) East Coast Corridor (Kharagpur -Vijayawada).
