(a) to (c): Railways have issued a new Non Fare Revenue Policy for encouraging viable proposals for generating revenue from non-conventional sources.

Zonal Railways and Divisions have been empowered under the policy to take decisions regarding revenue generating proposals, subject to feasibility and desirability which, inter-alia includes selection of specific events and locations renting out less busy stations for marriage ceremonies and other programmes.
