Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a demand since a long time for the construction of Hudera halt station on Soti Badi and Ratangarh-Sardarshahar rail line between Nahar Railway Station and Deeplana on the Sadulpur-Hanumangarh rail line;**
- (b) if so, whether the North-Western Railway has got a request from the public representatives in this regard;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Railways in this regard; and**
- (d) the time likely to be taken to set up the said two stations?**
