DIFFICULTY IN BOARDING AND DEBOARDING

†1787. DR. BHOLA SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether train commuters are facing a lot of difficulty in boarding and deboarding as the platform has not been constructed at the upper line of Hathidah Junction located in the Danapur division as a result of which apprehension of accident perpetually remains;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the measures being taken by the Government to get the platform constructed at the upper railway line of the Hathidah junction?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Hathidah (HTZ) is a 'B' category station. At present, 3 Platforms are available at this station, out of which 2 Platforms are of High level and one is a Rail level Platform. However, a proposal has been made for raising the platform as per the extant norms subject to availability of funds.
