Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds provided to various States, under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last three years, State/UT-wise including West Bengal;
- (b) the number of workers benefited/ likely to be benefited under MGNREGS during the last and the current year in various States, State/UT-wise and Genderwise;
- (c) the number of days for which employment is provided under the said scheme at present along with the wages fixed, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) whether any State or States are not been able to spend the allocated funds under MGNREGS and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?
