REVIVAL OF PONDS

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has started or proposes to start revival of ponds in the country keeping in view the scarcity of water;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the States in which ponds are being reconstructed and old ponds are being revived; and
- (c) the number of the ponds revived and the expenditure incurred thereon so far?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Works related to water resources development & management are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes such as scheme for Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies etc.

Till date 12404 water bodies (1085 in pilot scheme, 10855 in XI plan and 464 in XII plan) have been revived under the scheme of Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies. The State wise details are enclosed in **Annexure**. Central Assistance to the tune of Rs. 4280.80 crore (Rs. 197.30 crore in pilot scheme, Rs. 3818.83 crore in XI Plan and Rs. 264.67 crore in XII Plan) has been released to various States under this scheme till date.
