Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state :

- (a) whether different types of coal are allotted by the Government to various coal using sectors in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of type of coal allotted to Hindustan Zinc Limited, Zawar mines; and
- (c) the quantum of coal allotted to Hindustan Zinc Limited during the last three years and the current year along with the revenue earned therefrom?

ANSWER

- (a) : Coal is broadly classified into coking coal & non-coking coal, with each type having various specification. While coking coal is generally used in steel industries, non-coking coal is generally used for heating and process requirement of other industries. For grant of coal linkages to the non-regulated sector and regulated sector of the economy, policies dated 15.02.2016 and 22.05.2017 respectively have been issued.
- **(b) & (c)**: Fuel Supply Agreement signed between South Eastern Coalfields Ltd. and Hindustan Zinc Limited is for G10-G12 grades of Coal. The year-wise coal quantity supplied and revenue earned are as given in the table below:
