(a)& (b):As per information received, the grades of all the mines of Coal India Limited (CIL)were verified through Government Institutions and declared with theapproval of Coal Controller Organisation (CCO) under Rule 4(3) & (4) of the CollieryControl Rules, 2004. Based on the analysis of samples conducted, 189mines have been downgraded out of total 395 Mines of CIL.
