# WIND ENERGY PLANTS

## 1939. SHRI HARISH CHANDRA ALIAS HARISH DWIVEDI:

#### Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a): the number of wind energy plants functional in the country as on date and the quantum of electricity being produced from them, State-wise;

(b): the financial assistance provided by the Government to each of the States for setting up of these plants during the last three years and the current year, State-wise;

(c): whether the Union Government has received proposals from the various State Governments for setting up of these plants in their States; and

(d): if so, the details thereof, State-wise and the action taken by the Union Government thereon?

## ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR POWER, COAL, NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND MINES (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): As on 30.06.2017, the total wind power installed capacity in the country was over 32.5 GW. The State-wise details are given in **Table-A.** The Central Electricity Authority captures the wind power generation data on monthly basis and the total wind power generation during 2016-17 was 45.7 BU. The State-wise details are also given in **Table-A.**
