(a) & (b) Sports sciences have been made an integral part of sports diploma courses in coaching. In addition, selected coaches belonging to Sports Authority of India, State Governments and National Sports Federations are being given foreign training in sports sciences, strength & conditioning, etc. In the recent past 2 batches of 25 each have received training in the University of Birmingham.

(c) All the national campers are given sports science support along with coaching.
